1. Special Olympics registration will be held during the PAEC Center & PAEC Academy registration dates in August 2019.

- 2. All registration paperwork must be turned in <u>no later than Friday, September 27, 2019</u>. A new physical is also required.
- 3. Register in fall! If not, you must wait until the next school year.
- 4. There is a \$60.00 registration fee which must be paid <u>no later than Friday, September 27</u>, 2019. NOTE: Extra fee of \$10.00 to participate in bowling which will be collected in April. There are <u>no</u> fee waivers. This fee is non-transferrable and non-refundable.
- 5. The designated Special Olympics physical form must be completed by a health care professional and turned into PAEC no later than Friday, September 27, 2019. The designated Special Olympics physical form must be current from August 2019 to September 2020. Original signatures of doctor and parent as well as insurance required.
- 6. Parents/guardians will not be allowed to travel on the bus or van with the team or stay in dorm rooms with students. **No exceptions!** Only authorized Special Olympics athletes and coaches are allowed on bus. Overnight accommodations for parents/guardians at parent/guardian expense.
